How to Enter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review the Terms & Conditions before registering your team. • Register to access and download all Challenge resources. • Create a video no longer than 5 minutes that follows the Challenge prompts. • Upload your video to YouTube as an unlisted video. This keeps it private but viewable to judges. • Submit your video link and team details via the official https://forms.gle/TPUktYAaCEGhAJzh7 • Deadline: All entries must be submitted by Friday, June 13, 2024, 5:00 PM (ET). Late submissions will not be accepted.
Resources	<p>The registration fee is \$140 USD. Schools may enter multiple teams. This fee includes a complete package to support teachers and students throughout the challenge:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Challenge Workbook: A curriculum-aligned guide for teachers and students to work through the Challenge activities. • Science of Bees Guide: Easy-to-understand content about bee biology, vision, scent detection, and pollination. • Curriculum Alignment Overview: Mapping the Challenge to relevant science standards for Elementary Students (grades 4–6). • Challenge Checklist: A step-by-step list to help teams meet all Challenge requirements. • Judging Rubric: A clear scoring guide that assesses bee knowledge, creativity, teamwork, and communication. • Fun Activity Sheets: Printable games and puzzles to support learning.
Student Team Sizes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each team must consist of 2 to 4 students. Entries from teams exceeding this number will not be accepted. • Schools can enter multiple teams.

Judging	An expert panel at STEM Hub will evaluate all entries using a judging rubric. Judging results will not be shared with students or schools. The decisions of the judging panel are final.
