<b>Student Team Numbers</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Schools can enter multiple teams.</li> <li>• Teams must consist of 2 to 5 students. Entries from teams exceeding this number will not be accepted.</li> </ul>

<b>Judging &amp; Finals</b>	<p>An expert panel at STEM Hub will evaluate <b>all</b> entries using a judging rubric.</p> <p><b>VIC teams</b> that reach the finals will be required to attend the F1 Australian Grand Prix to present on stage in front of a panel of industry judges.</p> <p><b>Other States and Territories:</b> There is no requirement to present at the F1 Australian Grand Prix. Submissions will be reviewed by a panel of judges. Winners will be notified after the Grand Prix concludes.</p> <p>Judging results will not be shared with students or schools. The decisions of the judging panel are final.</p>
