How to Enter	 Review these Terms & Conditions before proceeding with registration. Download the Challenge resources after registering and follow the instructions. Complete all the activities. Create a video between 3 to 5 minutes long. Upload the video to YouTube as an UNLISTED video. Share the link by using this google form: https://forms.gle/rKFop3YRFNwyRDiB7 Ensure all entries are submitted by Friday, 15 November 2025, 5PM (AWST). Late submissions will not be accepted.
Eligible Year Levels	The Bee's Knees Challenge is open to students in Years 3 to 6. Entries from students outside these year levels will not be accepted.
School Registration Fee	 The registration fee is \$220 (incl. GST). Schools can enter multiple teams. This fee provides a complete package to support teachers and students throughout the challenge, including: 1_Challenge Workbook: A detailed, curriculum-aligned workbook that guides teachers and students through each activity in the challenge, ensuring they can easily create and submit their final video presentation. 2_The Science of Bees Guide: An easy-to-understand guide covering bee diversity, the physics of colours, and the chemistry of flower scents, tailored for grades 4 to 6. 3_Teacher Resource Curriculum Alignment: A list of how the challenge corresponds with specific Australian Curriculum codes, facilitating easy integration into classroom learning. 4_Challenge Checklist: A checklist designed to guide teams through every step of the challenge, ensuring that projects meet all the key requirements and showcase understanding of bee habitats.



 5_Challenge Judging Rubric: An easy to follow rubric tailored to assess the main components of the Challenge, ensuring that the students' understanding of bees, creativity, teamwork, and communication are evaluated fairly. 6_Fun Activity Sheets: Printable, game-style resources designed to make learning fun and interactive for students as they explore the challenge. Dedicated Support: Email support for any questions or issues during the challenge, ensuring a smooth experience.
Teams should consist of 2 to 4 students. Unfortunately, entries from teams outside this range cannot be accepted. Schools are welcome to enter as many teams as they wish.
An expert panel at STEM Hub will evaluate all entries using a judging rubric. Judging results will not be shared with students or schools. The decisions of the judging panel are final.
Winners will be publicly announced on the STEM Hub website on Friday, 28 November 2025, and winning teachers will receive notification via email. STEM Hub reserves the right to disclose the first names of all winning students and the names of their respective schools on the STEM Hub website and across social media platforms. STEM Hub reserves the right to use video footage or still images (digital assets) from the winning entries on its website and social media channels, as well as to distribute these digital assets to local media outlets.
